Dear Mr. Killip,

In compliance with RCW 19.285, WAC 480-109-120(2), and the requirements outlined in Commission Order No. 01 in Docket No. UE-230897 approving Avista's 2024-2025 Biennial Conservation Plan (BCP) with conditions, Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or the Company), respectfully submits its 2025 Electric Annual Conservation Plan (ACP).

Avista's Electric ACP represents program efforts by the Company in order to acquire electric energy efficiency savings for residential, commercial and industrial customers in the upcoming 2025 program year. For the 2025 ACP, the Company has identified estimated conservation savings in the amount of 37,649 megawatt-hours (MWh) from local efforts and a total of 45,883 MWh after including 8,234 MWh of regionally acquired savings from the Northwest Energy Efficiency Alliance (NEEA). The Company has provided in its ACP the annual estimated savings and budgets for each of its electric Energy Efficiency programs. Please see Appendix C for the annual program summary outlining Avista's planned savings by sector.
