Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On July 8, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment against Miracle Man Movers LLC d/b/a Miracle Man Movers (Miracle Man Movers or Company) in the amount of \$12,600 for violations of WAC 480-15-555, WAC 480-15-560, WAC 480-15-570, and WAC 480-15-590.

On August 1, 2022, the Company filed a response to the penalty assessment that included documents not made available to Commission staff (Staff) during the investigation. On August 11, 2022, Staff amended its safety investigation report of Miracle Man Movers.

Considering these factors, Staff recommends the penalty assessment against Miracle Man Movers in the amount of \$12,600 be withdrawn. Staff intends to file a separate penalty assessment based on the amended safety investigation report of Miracle Man Movers.
