STAFF'S MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION

By Order No. 08, service date July 22, 2003, the Commission directed Commission Staff to aggregate the data collected from CLECs operating in Washington, rather than masking the CLECs identities. *See* Paragraphs 23 and 33. The data is to be aggregated so that CLEC identities, trade secrets, and other highly confidential information are not exposed. Paragraphs 22, 23, and 33. The Order directs Staff to distribute the aggregated information pursuant to the Highly Confidential protective order. Paragraph 33.

Commission Staff now requests that the Commission clarify whether the aggregated data is to be designated as Highly Confidential, Confidential, or nonconfidential material. Because the aggregation must be sufficient to protect CLEC identities and to not expose trade secrets or other highly confidential information, Staff submits that a non-confidential designation is appropriate.
