**NOTICE REVISING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 16, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Order 01 – Prehearing Conference Order in the above-referenced docket establishing a procedural schedule. On April 18, and May 10, 2012, the Commission issued notices revising the procedural schedule.

On July 31, 2012, counsel for Stericycle of Washington, Inc., filed with the Commission an agreed Motion for Extension of Time to file prefiled direct testimony to enable the parties to complete discovery. During the hearing on discovery motions on August 8, 2012, the parties requested that the entire procedural schedule be revised to facilitate discovery and to expand the amount of time reserved for evidentiary hearings. The Commission finds good cause to revise the procedural schedule and grants the request as follows:
