## NOTICE RESCHEDULING HEARING (Now Set for Tuesday, August 13, 2013, at 1:30 p.m.)

Re: In the Matter of the Petition of CenturyLink Companies – Qwest Corporation, CenturyTel of Washington, CenturyTel of Inter Island, CenturyTel of Cowiche, and United Telephone Company of the Northwest to be Regulated Under an Alternative form of Regulation Pursuant to RCW 80.36.135, Docket UT-130477

## TO ALL PARTIES:

On July 29, 2013, the CenturyLink Companies – Qwest Corporation; CenturyTel of Washington; CenturyTel of Inter Island; CenturyTel of Cowiche; and United Telephone Company of the Northwest (Collectively referred to as CenturyLink) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Motion to Dismiss Sprint as an Intervenor (Motion) in the above-referenced proceeding.

On July 31, 2013, Sprint Nextel Corporation (Sprint) filed with the Commission a Motion to Compel Full Responses to Data Requests (Motion) in this proceeding.

On August 2, 2013, the Commission issued a notice scheduling a hearing for August 15, 2013, to resolve the Motions of CenturyLink and Sprint.

On August 5, 2013, Sprint informally notified the Commission that it has a conflicting hearing on August 15 and asked that the hearing be rescheduled to August 13 or 14, 2013. Sprint indicates that CenturyLink is available either of those days. The request is granted.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the hearing on the Motions of CenturyLink and Sprint is rescheduled to Tuesday, August 13, 2013, beginning at 1:30 p.m., in Room 206, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.
