RE: Docket U-210590—PacifiCorp’s Response Related to Performance Metrics – Phase 2A Work Plan

On January 5, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity to Provide Written Comments allowing the opportunity to comment on its proposed work plan for Phase 2A of this proceeding. PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp or Company) provides the following responsive comments:

This proceeding is currently in Phase 1. At the conclusion of Phase 1, the Commission will be issuing a policy statement that will “provide guidance on defining regulatory goals, desired outcomes, design principals, and metrics.”¹ PacifiCorp appreciates that the Commission “recognizes that the complexity of the issues raised in the statute may require the Commission to revise the Work Plan during the process.”² The Company believes that the Phase 1 policy statement may inform the Company’s comments on the scope and timing of Phase 2A as it relates to the establishment, reporting, and review of metrics. Accordingly, PacifiCorp would like to reserve its comments on the work plan for Phase 2A at this time.
