BENCH REQUEST No. 3:

Please provide details on which regional Bell Operating Companies (RBOC) and Level 3 have agreed to use a single trunking architecture using factors. For each such arrangement, please identify the RBOC, the state in which the arrangement occurs, the type of trunks involved (LIS, Feature Group D, etc.), the types of traffic mixed on trunk groups (inter-state, intra-state, VoIP, VNXX, etc.), the type of signaling involved (SS7 or ISDN PRI), and the factors used to allocate costs.

LEVEL 3'S RESPONSE TO BENCH REQUEST NO. 3:

Level 3 and Verizon, AT&T and BellSouth exchange ISP-bound, VoIP and 1+ dialed traffic (terminating only) over Level 3's massive interconnection network with each of these carriers. These carriers agreed to use Level 3's measure and factors method because it conserves network resources and because it produces accurate, reliable and verifiable results.

As detailed in the Direct Testimony of Mr. Wilson and Mr. Greene, Level 3 works closely with each of these local telephone companies to calculate the proper rating for traffic. Level 3 would use these very same processes with Qwest. So Qwest would be paid according to the same timeframes, same manner and same amounts under the factors method. So verification would be the same with Qwest, and audit verification would be the same with Qwest, just as they are with the other RBOCs.

From a network perspective, the interconnection architecture proposed by Level 3 with Qwest uses SS7 signaling just as it does with the other RBOCs. Finally, Verizon, AT&T and Owest all use the same types of switches, all of which have great flexibility in their operation, so these switches can easily route 1+ dialed traffic at interconnection trunks. Level 3 utilizes this architecture with Verizon, AT&T and BellSouth in a total of 34 states as listed below:
