Provide the following information about the amount(s) of power to be delivered to PSE pursuant to the Coal Transition PPA if output from the Centralia Transition Coal Facility is reduced or curtailed. (If the answers differ depending on the reasons for any such reductions or curtailments, specify what the differences are. Provide citations to the Coal Transition PPA documenting each answer.):

- (a) Amounts of energy to be delivered to PSE if output from the Centralia Coal Transition Facility is reduced or curtailed.
- (b) Costs of energy to be delivered to PSE if output from the Centralia Coal Transition Facility is reduced or curtailed.
- (c) Delivery point(s) for energy to be delivered to PSE if output from the Centralia Coal Transition Facility is reduced or curtailed.

Response:

- (a) Section 3.1(a) of the Coal Transition PPA and Exhibit B to the Coal Transition PPA (also shown in Exhibit No. ____(RG-1HCT) at page 9, Table 1) require TransAlta Centralia Generation LLC ("TransAlta Centralia") to deliver during the Delivery Term the amounts of energy (Hourly Contract Quantity) stated in clauses (i) through (iv) of such section unless such deliveries are prevented by Force Majeure.
- (b) The Contract Price for the Hourly Contract Quantity delivered to any of the Delivery Points is as set forth in Section 3.1(b) of the Coal Transition PPA.

(c) Energy deliveries are to be made from the Centralia Transition Coal Facility ("CTCF") except to the extent deliveries from that facility are reduced or curtailed for any reason. If energy deliveries from the CTCF are reduced or curtailed for any reason, TransAlta Centralia has the right under Section 3.2(b) of the Coal Transition PPA to provide the energy from one or more other sources so long as the energy is delivered to one of the Delivery Points specified in Section 3.3(b) of the Coal Transition PPA.
