5. Deviations notes, exceptions and recommendations

Explain in detail:

Site is located at 4234 B Mount Constitution Rd, Olga WA in San Juan County. Lat 48-40-49N, Longitude 122-50-21W

The Mt Constitution tower is not owned by CTL. Here CTL leases space on a third-party-owned tower and so there is no alarming in the building. Tower is in very good shape. The ice shield protecting our antenna towards Bellingham had a few loose bolts which were tightened while on site. I found a couple of air seals loose on the coax, tightened those also. I checked 50-75 bolts in the general area of our antennas. Site is clean and free of weeds and debris. The key was returned to the Central Office in Friday Harbor at the conclusion of my inspection.

I tried to get access to this site in January and February, but the road was blocked with ice, snow and fallen trees. This inspection was completed March 29, 2017. Should take that into consideration for scheduling an inspection next year.
