**PUBLIC COUNSEL OBJECTION TO
RESPONSE OF PACIFICORP**

Public Counsel hereby objects to the response of Pacificorp to Public Counsel's motion to reopen Docket No. UE-991255. Pacificorp was not a party to Docket No. UE-991255. The companies did not petition to intervene in each other's proceedings, and they were not joined as parties. The Commission did, in its Order of Consolidation (November 23, 1999), specify that evidentiary hearings would be consolidated, and that was done and the evidentiary hearings concluded.

Our motion is only in the Avista docket, and there is no basis for the parties which did not intervene in that docket to submit comment upon the motion.
