State any and all conditions under which TransAlta Centralia may reduce deliveries of power from the Centralia Transition Coal Facility pursuant to the Coal Transition PPA. In particular, state whether TransAlta Centralia may reduce deliveries of power from the facility because it is more costly than market-priced power. Provide citations to the Coal Transition PPA documenting all responses provided to this question.

Response:

Section 3.2(b) of the Coal Transition PPA contemplates that deliveries of output from the Centralia Transition Coal Facility ("CTCF") may be reduced or curtailed for any reason; however, PSE will be required to receive the Hourly Contract Quantity that is not delivered from the CTCF only if such Hourly Contract Quantity is delivered to a Delivery Point (as defined in Section 1.1 of the Coal Transition PPA).
