1 Household Goods Permit No. HG-60853 stands in the name of Out-Right Moving Services, LLC, and authorizes the services therein set forth.

2 On April 4, 2004, Docket No. TV-031024 was issued suspending Household Goods Permit No. HG-60853 for failure to file acceptable proof of liability and property damage insurance with this Commission.

3 Mr. Spillman has requested that Permit No. HG-60853 be further suspended. Mr. Spillman is currently seeking reinstatement of his insurance policy and has requested additional time.

4 The Commission having reviewed the circumstances and being fully advised of the facts and noting that Out-Right Moving Services, LLC, will not be operating vehicles under his Household Goods permit authority, is of the opinion that it would not be detrimental to the interest of the public to further suspend Household Goods permit HG-60853 until June 21, 2004.

ORDER

5 Therefore, this order further suspends Household Goods Permit No. HG-60853. As the certificate is suspended, the holder is directed to cease all operations associated with this permit. To avoid cancellation, the certificate holder must file acceptable proof of insurance or request a hearing by June 21, 2004 to show why the certificate should not be canceled.
