TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:

On February 19, 2004, Blaine-Bay Refuse, Inc. (Blaine-Bay) emailed the presiding Administrative Law Judge and parties a letter requesting an extension of its February 23, 2004, filing date for supplementing its motion to amend to March 8, 2004. The letter states that "Blaine-Bay Refuse, Inc. and Sanitary Service Company, Inc. continue to be in on-going settlement negotiations which could possibly result in resolving all issues." Sanitary Service Company, Inc. does not object to the extension as long as the date for filing its responsive pleading is similarly extended.

The Commission finds that it is consistent with the public interest to grant Blaine-Bay's request for an extension. The January 14, 2004, prehearing conference order in this docket is amended to reflect that Blaine-Bay must supplement its motion to amend by **Monday, March 8, 2004**. Likewise, the order is amended to reflect that the response of Staff and Protestant must be filed by **Monday, March 29, 2004**, and Blaine-Bay's reply by **Tuesday, April 13, 2004**.
