MEMORANDUM

- 1 **PROCEEDINGS.** Docket UW-060662 involves a Commission complaint against Fragaria Landing Water Company (Fragaria or Company) challenging the reasonableness of the Company’s rates and charges. The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) convened a prehearing conference in this docket at Olympia, Washington on May 31, 2006. The Commission established a procedural schedule by order entered following the prehearing conference.

- 2 **MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE.** On July 26, 2006, Staff filed a letter requesting that the procedural schedule be revised to allow for settlement negotiations, which have been delayed due to the unavoidable unavailability of key Commission staff. Staff’s letter states Fragaria has agreed to the request. We consider the filing as a Motion for Continuance under WAC 480-07-385.

- 3 **COMMISSION DETERMINATION.** This is a first agreed continuance in this proceeding and the basis stated in Staff’s motion establishes good cause.

Accordingly, the Commission concludes it should grant Staff's motion and adopt the revised procedural schedule set forth in the motion and attached to this order as an appendix.
