- On June 18, 2008, AMS Moving & Storage of Portland, Inc. filed with the Commission an application for permanent authority to transport household goods in the state of Washington under the provisions of RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-15.

- 3 On November 25, 2008, the Commission entered a notice of intent to cancel the applicant's temporary authority and reject its application for permanent authority, and provide an opportunity for hearing.
- 4 By letter dated December 16, 2008, the applicant notified the Commission that it does not wish to proceed with the matter and requests that this application be withdrawn.
- 5 The Commission does not respond to the allegations contained in the applicant's December 16, 2008, letter.

The Commission will schedule your request for review by issuing a notice of hearing to be held before an administrative law judge. The Commission, at its discretion, may consider your request for review in an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05 Part IV, or in a brief adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.482 through .494. Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.

The Commission will grant a late-filed request for review only on a showing of good cause, including a satisfactory explanation of why the person did not timely file the request. A form for late-filed requests is available on the Commission's Web site.
