TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a notice on January 10, 2011, that it would review Cascade Natural Gas Corporation's (Cascade) integrated resource plan (IRP) for natural gas service at a public meeting on February 25, 2011. **By this notice, the Commission reschedules the review and invites the public to comment on Cascade's natural gas IRP at a recessed open meeting of the Commission to be held on Monday, April 25, 2011, at 1:30 p.m.** The meeting will be held at the Commission's headquarters, Room 206, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.

An "integrated resource plan" describes the mix of generation and supply resources and efficiency improvements that will meet both the current and future energy demands at the lowest cost to the utility and its ratepayers.

Cascade representatives will present the plan to the Commission and will respond to questions from the Commissioners and the public. A copy of the plan is on file in the library at the Commission's offices in Olympia. Requests for copies of the plan, if needed, should be directed to Cascade, not the Commission.
