Dear Ms. Radcliff:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed a Preproposal Statement of Inquiry (CR-101) regarding fees for federal Telecommunications Act activities on October 5, 2011, at WSR # 11-20-104. The Commission has decided not to proceed with this rulemaking proceeding and requests that the CR-101 published in WSR # 11-20-104 be withdrawn.

After reviewing data on the expense of performing Telecommunications Act services and possible revenues from establishing fees for these services, the Commission has determined, for the present time, that the revenues gained through fees would not be significant to warrant the additional costs of a rulemaking. Thus, the Commission is withdrawing its notice of a rulemaking proceeding in this docket, and will notify stakeholders of the withdrawal of this proceeding.
