## TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 12, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered a Notice of Brief Adjudication in this matter. The Notice set October 11, 2012, as the date for parties to present their oral statements.

On September 20, 2012, Commission Staff notified the Commission that it had reached an agreement with Ironman Moving Services on all matters raised in this docket. Commission Staff indicated the parties will soon be filing a Settlement Agreement and supporting Narrative. Accordingly, the parties ask the Commission to cancel the hearing date set in this matter.

The Commission finds that canceling the brief adjudication is reasonable in light of the parties' successful settlement negotiations. However, the Commission will need to review and approve the proposed Settlement Agreement before this docket can be closed. Therefore, the Commission will cancel the hearing date on condition the parties file their proposed Settlement Agreement and supporting Narrative by the end of this week.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the deadline for the parties to file a Settlement Agreement and supporting Narrative is Friday, September 28, 2012. The Commission will review and consider the parties' proposed settlement documents when filed and, in accordance with WAC 480-07-740(1)(d), anticipates issuing an order without need for a settlement hearing.
