- On April 17, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Penalty Assessment UW-140598 against Washington Water Supply, Inc. (Washington Water Supply or Company) in the amount of \$11,600, alleging that the Company acquired and has been operating two water systems, Silent Sky and Bainbridge 1, that were not listed in the Company's tariff. The Commission assessed penalties against Washington Water Supply for failing to file either an application for a transfer of property, or revisions to its tariff as required by WAC 480-110-433.
- On May 2, 2014, Washington Water Supply Water filed with the Commission a request for hearing stating that the two water systems, Silent Sky and Bainbridge 1, are Class B systems that are owned and regulated by Kitsap County Health Department. Washington Water Supply further states that it has decided to not seek ownership of the two water systems and transfer the systems to the local PUD.
- On May 20, 2014, Commission staff filed a response stating that it supports the Company's request for a hearing.
- Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for resolving the issues in this matter.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 1:30 p.m., on Monday, August 18, 2014, in Room 206, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.

- The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.
- Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.
- Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents **no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, July 28, 2014**, and bring an original and three (3) copies to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140 and 145.
