RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Robany Work Services, LLC Commission Staff Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties of Order 01 Docket TV-171143

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On December 6, 2017, Robany Work Services, LLC (Robany or company) was assessed a penalty of \$12,400. The penalty was a result of 124 violations of WAC 480-15. The company requested mitigation of the penalty, which was reduced to \$4,000 in Order 01. The commission suspended \$2,000 of the penalty for a period of two years subject to the following conditions: (1) Robany not incur any repeat violations upon reinspection; and (2) pay the \$2,000 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On March 16, 2018, the company paid the \$2,000 non-suspended portion of the penalty in full.

On May 30, 2018, staff completed the follow-up investigation as outlined in Order 01. Robany received a satisfactory rating without incurring any repeat violations.

Staff finds that Robany satisfied the conditions of Order 01 and recommends that the \$2,000 suspended penalty be waived.
