RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Island Airporter LLC Commission Staff Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties of Order 01 Docket TC-180268

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On May 14, 2018, Island Airporter LLC (Island Airporter or company) was assessed a penalty of \$14,500. The penalty was a result of 145 violations of WAC 480-30. The company requested mitigation of the penalty, which was reduced to \$7,000 in Order 01. The commission suspended \$5,500 of the penalty for a period of two years subject to the conditions: (1) Island Airporter not incur any repeat violations of 40 C.F.R. §387.31(a) upon reinspection; and (2) pay the \$1,500 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On June 7, 2018, the company paid the \$1,500 non-suspended portion of the penalty in full.

On May 28, 2020, staff completed the follow-up investigation as outlined in Order 01. No violations of 49 C.F.R. § 387.31(a) were discovered.

Staff finds that Island Airporter satisfied the conditions of Order 01 and recommends that the \$5,500 suspended penalty be waived.
