#### TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 6, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Instituting Special Proceeding, in the above-captioned docket (Order 01). Through Order 01, the Commission initiated a special proceeding to determine whether Sunrise Acres Water Services, LLC (Sunrise Acres or Company) is operating as a water company subject to the Commission's jurisdiction without the requisite authority. The Commission gave notice of an evidentiary hearing set for February 4, 2019, at 1:30 p.m.

On the morning of February 4, 2019, an associate of Tom Harrison, the owner of Sunrise Acres, informed the Commission that Mr. Harrison would not be able to attend the hearing due to a Company emergency. In light of the Company's emergency and adverse weather conditions, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the hearing set for February 4, 2019 at 1:30 p.m.

Sunrise Acres and Commission staff must confer and submit to the presiding officer a proposed new date for hearing no later than **5 p.m., Friday, February 8, 2019**.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that the hearing set for February 4, 2019, at 1:30 p.m. is cancelled. The parties must submit to the presiding officer a proposed a new hearing date by 5 p.m. on Friday, February 8, 2019.
