RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Merchants Parcel Delivery, Inc. d/b/a Merchants Moving & Storage Co. in the Amount of \$16,200, Docket TV-190326

TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 12, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Granting Mitigation to \$8,200; Imposing and Suspending Penalties (Order 01) against Merchants Parcel Delivery, Inc., d/b/a Merchants Moving & Storage (Merchants or Company). Order 01 imposed a penalty of \$8,200 against Merchants, \$5,000 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, subject to the conditions that: a) Merchants not incur any repeat violations of critical regulations upon re-inspection, and b) the Company timely pay the \$3,200 portion of the penalty.

On February 11, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had timely paid the \$3,200 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and that the Company has not incurred any further violations of critical regulations upon re-inspection.

The Commission finds that Merchants has complied with the conditions of Order 01. The \$5,000 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
