Dear Mr. Johnson,

On January 22, 2020, the Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice Suspending Deadline to Respond to Penalty Assessment and Notice Requiring Filing of Status Updates (Notice) in Docket TE-190996. The Notice extended Tri Cities Limo LLC, d/b/a Tri Cities Limo's ("Tri Cities Limo" or "Company") time to respond to the penalty assessment and directed Tri Cities Limo to file monthly status updates regarding its appeal of the inspection giving rise to the violations at issue in Docket TE-190996. The Notice required Tri Cities Limo to file a status report every 30 days, with the first report due by 5 p.m. on February 24, 2020.

As of the date of filing this letter, Tri Cities Limo has not filed a status report regarding the status of its appeal, and therefore Commission Staff submits that the Company has not complied with the Commission's January 22 Notice.
