RE: UE-220400-Avista Utilities 2022 Renewable Target Compliance Report

On May 31, 2021, in compliance with WAC 480-109, Avista Utilities (Avista or the Company) filed its "Compliance Report" demonstrating compliance with the renewable energy component of I-937, the Energy Independence Act, for 2020. Based on conversations with Staff, Avista updated its Renewable Target Compliance report to reflect a total cost changed from -2.1% to -0.6% which the Company filed on July 21, 2022. After this updated filing, Staff identified additional changes that were necessary to the Company's incremental cost calculation workpapers, such that all costs on the first tab needed to be zeroed out and prorated on the second tab to reflect the RECs actually used for compliance. The updated workpapers are enclosed with this filing.
