I. INTRODUCTION

In accordance with WAC 480-07-370(b3), PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp or Company) petitions the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) for an order authorizing the Company to defer costs associated with COVID-19 public health emergency from the date of this petition until the emergency is declared over. PacifiCorp seeks deferral of these costs to track and preserve them for later ratemaking treatment.

II. BACKGROUND

PacifiCorp is an electric utility and public service company doing business in the state of Washington under RCW 80.04.010, and its public utility operations, retail rates, service, and accounting practices are subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.
