RATE INCREASE NOTICE FOR ROLL-OFF SERVICE

Dear Customer:

June 30, 2023

Peninsula Disposal Sanitation Service, Inc. has filed a request for a rate increase with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC). The last general rate increase was approved by the UTC September 1, 2020. Since that time, the Company has experienced higher costs for employee wages, benefits, fuel, truck equipment and has purchased additional capital assets.

If approved, the proposed rates below will become effective August 1, 2023. The rates will increase as follows:
