#### REPORTS AS REFERENCED IN WAC 480-123-070 AND WAC 480-123-080

Hat Island Telephone Company (the "Company") hereby submits the following reports in accordance with WAC 480-123-070 and WAC 480-123-080.

Report 1: WAC 480-123-070(1)(a): Attached is a copy of the Company's NECA-1 Report for the calendar year 2006,<sup>2</sup> that, as of the date of the report, the Company has reported as the basis for support from the federal high-cost fund. That report also includes certain data for the calendar year 2005.

<u>Report 2</u>: WAC 480-123-070(1)(b): The Company reports that the investments and expenses reported under Report 1, above, benefited customers as follows:

Through the expenditure of these funds, the Company was able to continue to provide services at a level that the Company believes meets the intent set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 254 of providing high quality telecommunications services to customers in the service area for which the Company is designated as an ETC.<sup>3</sup> The Company has made expenditures and investments over the past several years, which allow it to provide quality telecommunications services to its customers in its designated ETC service area. Those expenditures and investments, including those reflected in Report 1 above, generally benefit all customers receiving the federal high-cost fund supported services<sup>4</sup> from the Company within its designated ETC service area.

<u>Report 3</u>: WAC 480-123-070(4): During the calendar year 2006, the Company did not receive from either the Federal Communications Commission or the Consumer Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Washington any complaints against the Company made to them by the Company's customers.

Report 4: WAC 480-123-080(1)(b) and (2): The Company reports as follows:

As they are known to the Company at the date of this Report, the planned investment and expenses related to Washington state for the periods January 1, 2007, through December 31, 2007, and January 1, 2008, through December 31, 2008, that the Company expects to use as a basis to request federal high-cost fund support for those periods, respectively, are expected to be relatively similar to those investments and expenses the Company has set forth in its information for calendar year 2006 filed under Report 1, above, taking into account normal fluctuations in investment and expense levels. The Company expects that levels of expenses in each of those years will remain relatively the same as those it

experienced in calendar year 2006, subject to the effects of inflation and other commonly experienced changes in cost of labor and materials. The Company does not anticipate The Company's major adjustments in staffing levels for either relevant period. investment plans for calendar years 2007 and 2008 directly affecting federal high-cost fund supported services offered by it in its designated ETC service area do not include a major construction project at the present time. The Company expects that, in each of the calendar years 2007 and 2008, it will have relatively the same level of expenditure and upgrades investment maintenance, replacement and minor related to telecommunications equipment and plant as occurred in calendar year 2006.

The expected benefit to customers from the anticipated investment and expenditures is that customers will continue to receive a high level of telecommunications service. The Company further expects that the continued receipt of federal high-cost fund support will allow the Company to continue to provide the supported services at rates that are reasonably comparable to the rates for such services in urban areas. All customers in the Company's designated ETC service area will benefit from the expected level of support by continuing to have available to them services that are reasonably comparable to the telecommunications services offered in urban areas at rates that are reasonably comparable to the rates for such services in urban areas.
