TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:

On January 29, 1993, I initiated a conference call with all parties to the proceeding to discuss scheduling. An agreement was reached as follows:

- O The company will pre-file Mr. Hogan's revised testimony by the close of business February 5, 1993.
- O We will convene in Room 250 at 8:00 a.m. on February 11, 1993, and begin with the testimony of Mr. Campbell, followed by Mr. Sullivan. Time permitting, we will then move on to Mr. Johnson. The hearing may last until 6:00 p.m.
- We will reconvene at 8:00 a.m. on February 12, 1993, and pick up where we left off on the 11th. Time permitting, we will then continue with Mr. Gustafson. Again, we may go until 6:00 p.m.
- O The next hearing will be on February 22, 1993. Torgerson will testify first, then Mr. Gustafson, then Mr. Hogan. We will continue on the 23rd if necessary. The start time on the 22nd will be announced during the hearing on the 12th, but in any event will not be later than 9:00 a.m.
