RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Pacific Power & Light Company, Docket UE-152253

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 1, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 12 in the above-referenced docket which, among other things, established a two year rate plan for Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power or Company). One of the conditions of Order 12 was a requirement that Pacific Power file any proposed decoupling rate adjustment to Schedule 93 by December 1, 2017.

On December 1, 2017, the Company filed a revised tariff sheet in Schedule 93, proposing its first decoupling rate adjustment. On January 19, 2018, Commission staff (Staff) filed a Motion to Reject the Filing for Noncompliance with Order 12, and on February 15, 2018, the Commission entered Order 16, which granted Staff's motion, rejected the proposed tariff sheet, and required a further compliance filing.

On March 6, 2018, Pacific Power filed its revised tariff sheets in compliance with Order 16, and on March 23, 2018, the Company filed further revisions to the tariff sheets.

Also on March 23, 2018, Staff filed a letter informing the Commission that it had reviewed the revised compliance filing and determined that the tariff sheets comply with Orders 12 and 16.

The Commission has reviewed Pacific Power's submissions and finds that the revised tariff sheets comply with the applicable requirements in Orders 12 and 16. The Commission authorizes the revised tariff sheets the Company submitted in this docket on March 23, 2018, to be effective on April 1, 2018.
