Response to WUTC Data Request 25

The Company clarifies that the two referenced confidential work papers were provided with the Company’s response to WUTC Data Request 16 dated November 13, 2023, and were both provided in Confidential Attachment WUTC 16-2. In addition, the Company clarifies that this request is specifically referencing confidential file “2022 Hourly Owned-Contracted Renewable and Non-Emitting generation-STF Purchases CONF”. Based on the foregoing clarifications, the Company responds as follows:

Referencing confidential file “2022 Hourly Owned-Contracted Renewable and Non-Emitting generation-STF Purchases CONF”, tab “MIDC Wanapum-PR”, the Company responds as follows:

The data provided in tab “MIDC Wanapum-Priest Rapids” provides hourly generation data corresponding to the Company’s Mid-Columbia (Mid-C) contracts relevant to calendar year 2022. The data is included in PacifiCorp’s actual net power costs (NPC) file as two separate entries. Column G “Mid-C WAPR (LU)” in tab “MIDC Wanapum-Priest Rapids” provides long-term firm (LTF) hourly map which maps to “Grant Surplus” under “Mid-Columbia Contracts” in the Company’s actual NPC report. Columns H through G in tab “MIDC Wanapum-Priest Rapids” provide short-term firm (STF) hourly data and are accounted for in “Short-Term Firm Purchases” in the Company’s actual NPC report.

“Mid-C WAPR (LU)” – The LTF Priest Rapids project product sales contract between PacifiCorp and Grant Public Utility District (PUD).

“PAC 2022 MP” – PacifiCorp exercised its Meaningful Priority (MP) rights and elected to receive its 7.51 percent Reasonable Portion (RP) allocation for calendar year 2022 from Grant PUD Priest Rapids project.

“PAC 2022 EWEB MP Share” – PacifiCorp’s purchase of Eugene Water and Electric Board’s (EWEB) MP rights of Grant PUD’s Priest Rapids project.

“PAC 2022 Auction Slice” – PacifiCorp’s was awarded a 4.22 percent share of the Priest Rapids project at the 2022 Open Market Sale of the Priest Rapids

project power.

“PAC 2022 Tacoma MP Share” – PacifiCorp’s purchase of Tacoma Power’s (City of Tacoma Public Utility District (PUD)) MP rights of Grant PUD’s Priest Rapids project.
