TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 1, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 12 in the above-referenced docket which, among other things, established a two year rate plan for Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power or Company) and required Pacific Power file any proposed decoupling rate adjustment to its Schedule 93 annually, by December 1, until 2020.

On November 30, 2018, the Company filed revised tariff sheets in Schedule 93, proposing its second decoupling rate adjustment. On January 8, 2019, Commission staff filed a letter informing the Commission that it had reviewed the tariff sheets and determined that they comply with Order 12.

The Commission has reviewed Pacific Power’s submission and finds that the revised tariff sheets comply with the requirements of Order 12. The Commission authorizes the revised tariff sheets the Company filed in this docket on November 30, 2018, to become effective on February 1, 2019, by operation of law.
