RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Puget Sound Energy, Dockets UE-220066, UG-220067, and UG-210918 (Consolidated)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 31, 2022, Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-60, Tariff G, Electric Service, and its currently effective Tariff WN U-2, Natural Gas. The Company characterizes this filing as a general rate case (GRC).

On March 3, 2022, the Commission entered Order 03, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing, which established a procedural schedule that includes, among other things, an evidentiary hearing set for October 3, 2022, and October 4, 2022. The procedural schedule allowed for a public comment hearing to be scheduled at a later date.

On August 5, 2022, PSE filed a multiparty Settlement Agreement (Settlement Agreement) on behalf of PSE, Commission staff, King County, the Public Counsel Unit of the Washington Office of the Attorney General, and Walmart. This Settlement Agreement pertains to the Company's Green Direct program.

On August 12, 2022, counsel for PSE contacted the presiding administrative law judge to state that PSE had reached a full multiparty settlement in principle with Staff and three intervenors and a partial multiparty settlement with Federal Executive Agencies and Microsoft.

On August 17, 2022, the Commission issued a notice suspending the procedural schedule with the exception of the evidentiary hearing set to begin on October 3.

The Commission now establishes the time for a virtual public comment hearing to provide members of the public with an opportunity to present oral comments to the Commission on the issues raised in these matters.
