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- I On August 26, 2008, in Docket TG-081576, Freedom 2000, LLC d/b/a Cando Recycling and Disposal (Freedom) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application to provide solid waste collection service within Point Roberts, Washington. Notice of the Application was published in the Commission's weekly Docket of September 24, 2009.¹
- 2 The Commission did not receive any protests to the application in Docket TG-081576.

¹ The Application was published in several Commission Dockets and was heard at various open meetings between the period of August 26, 2008, and September 24, 2009.

- ³ On October 26, 2009, within thirty days of the notice of the application in Docket TG-081576, Points Recycling and Refuse, L.L.C d/b/a Point Recycling and Refuse (Point Recycling) filed an application in Docket TG-091687 to provide solid waste collection service within Point Roberts. This application overlaps in part the authority requested by Freedom. Notice of the application was published in the Commission's weekly Docket of November 3, 2009.
- 4 The Commission did not receive any protests in Docket TG-091687.
- 5 The Commission will jointly consider these applications for certificates of public convenience and necessity for authority to provide solid waste collection service within the Point Roberts area.
- 6 The Commission consolidates these applications for joint consideration under WAC 480-70-011, which provides:

(1) The commission may consolidate applications for certificated authority for joint consideration if:

(a) The authority requested in the applications overlaps in whole or in part; and

(b) The subsequent application was filed within thirty days of the mailing date of the application docket notice of the original application.

Joint consideration will also address the requirements of Ashbacker Radio v. FCC.²

7 The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under RCW Title 81, and has legal authority to regulate persons seeking to furnish solid waste collection services under RCW 81.77 and WAC 480-70. The issues in the proceedings are whether Freedom 2000, LLC and Points Recycling and Refuse, L.L.C., meet the requirements for solid waste certificates, including whether there is public need for the proposed services, whether any existing Commission-certificated solid waste collection companies serving the territories sought in the two applications of are not providing service to the satisfaction of the Commission and whether granting the applications is otherwise consistent with the public interest.

8 Inasmuch as the foregoing matters involve related principles of law and overlapping authority, it is appropriate that they be consolidated for hearing and determination pursuant to WAC 480-07-320 and WAC 480-70-111.
