PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power and Light Company submits the enclosed Multi-Party Settlement Stipulation along with Joint Testimony in Support of the Settlement Stipulation.

Sierra Club has not signed the Stipulation, but has represented that it does not oppose the settlement reached by the Settling Parties. Additionally, Settling Parties had agreed to file the stipulation today, July 17, 2020. Settling Parties received a signature page from Staff on July 16, 2020, but subsequently needed to update the signature blocks. Due to the furlough, PacifiCorp cannot obtain Staff's signature on the revised signature block page. Accordingly, rather than file Staff's signature page with the incorrect identification of the executing parties, PacifiCorp will supplement this filing with Staff's signature on Monday July 20, 2020.
