- 2. This certificate must be kept on file at the main office of the gas company except when directed to be transmitted to the Commission, and shall be subject at all times to inspection by the authorized representatives of the Commission.
- 3. This certificate shall be subject to revocation and cancellation by the Commission upon a showing of procurement by false affidavit or representation.
- 4. This certificate is subject to the terms, conditions and provisions of the orders in Cause Nos. U-8841, U-8843, U-8937, U-9047, U-9052, U-9194, U-9238, U-9239, U-9253, U-9263, U-9264, U-9360, U-9388, U-9394 and U-9407, U-9450, U-9467, U-9469, U-9596, U-9600, U-9708, U-9759, U-9808, U-9807, U-9819, U-9790, U-9822, U-9864, U-9860, U-9872, U-9873, and U-10001.
- 5. This certificate is subject to the terms, conditions and provisions of the Order in Cause No. U-74-19, effective May 22, 1974, pursuant to which this certificate is issued.

On April 11, 1974, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade), a Washington corporation, filed an application to amend its present Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire, No. 4, amended, to include additional areas in Adams, Benton, Kitsap, Skagit and Walla Walla Counties. (Appendices A-2, A-4, A-11, A-13 and A-16, amended.)

Cascade is presently certificated for and is now providing gas service in the above-designated counties. The additional areas requested are contiguous to the aforesaid presently certificated areas.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Cascade Natural Gas Corporation, a Washington corporation, operates a gas plant for hire in this state and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- 2. Cascade has heretofore been issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire, No. 4, amended.
- 3. Cascade has filed an application to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, No. 4, amended, to include additional areas contiguous to its presently certificated areas in Adams, Benton, Kitsap, Skagit and Walla Walla Counties.
- 4. The operation of a gas plant for hire in the additional areas requested is or will be required by the public convenience and necessity.
- 5. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire, No. 4, amended, presently held by Cascade Natural Gas Corporation, should be further amended to include the additional areas applied for herein.

OKDER

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That the application of Cascade Natural Gas Corporation to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire, No. 4, amended, to include additional areas contiguous to its presently certificated areas in Adams, Benton, Kitsap, Skagit and Walla Walla Counties is hereby approved and said Certificate shall be amended in accordance with attached Appendices A-2, A-4, A-11, A-13 and A-16, amended, which, by this reference, are made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

- 2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire, No. 4, amended, issued pursuant to Order Paragraph No. 1, above, supersedes and cancels the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire, No. 4, as amended and issued to Cascade Natural Gas Corporation on January 20, 1972, in Cause No. U-10001. Said Certificate of January 20, 1972, shall be forthwith returned to this Commission.
- 3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the Certificate issued pursuant to Order Paragraph No. 1, above, is subject to the terms, conditions, and provisions of the Orders in Cause Nos. U-8841, U-8843, U-8937, U-9041, U-9052, U-9194, U-9238, U-9239, U-9253, U-9263, U-9264, U-9360, U-9388, U-9394 and U-9407, U-9450, U-9467, U-9469, U-9596, U-9600, U-9708, U-9759, U-9807, U-9808, U-9819, U-9790, U-9822, U-9860, U-9864, U-9872, U-9873 and U-10001.
- 4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That jurisdiction over this Cause is retained to effectuate the provisions of this order.

APPENDIX A-4 AMENDED - LEGAL DESCRIPTION - BREMERTON, PORT ORCHARD AND POULSBO AND VICINITY - KITSAP COUNTY

All of the incorporated area comprising the cities of Bromerton, Port Orchard and Poulsbo and additional portions of Kitsap County lying within the area described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the north line of Sec. 7, T. 26 N., R. 1 E.W.M., intersects the easterly meander line of Hood Canal; thence southerly to a point where said meander. line intersects the west line of Sec. 12, T. 25 N., R. 1 W.; thence south along the west lines of Secs. 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36, T. 25 N., R. 1 W., and along the west lines of Secs. 1, 12, 13, 24 and 25, T. 24 N., R. 1 W., to the southwest corner of said Sec. 25; thence west along the north lines of Secs. 35 and 34, T. 24 N., R. 1 W., to the northwest corner of said Sec. 34; thence south along the west line of said Sec. 34, and along the west lines of Secs. 3, 10, 15, 22, 27 and 34, T. 23 N., R. 1 W., to the southwest corner of said Sec. 34; thence West along the south lines of Secs. 34 and 35, T. 23 N., R. 1 W., to the southeast corner of said Sec. 35; thence northeast through Sec. 36, T. 23 N., R. 1 W., and through Secs. 30, 20 and 16, T. 23 N., R. 1 E., to the northeast corner of said Sec. 16; thence east along the south lines of Secs. 11 and 12, T. 23 N., R. 1 E., and the south line of Sec. 7, T. 23 N., R. 2 E. to the south-east corner of said Sec. 7; thence north along the east line to the northeast corner of said Sec. 7; thence east along the south line of Secs. 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1, T. 23 N., R. 2 E., to the intersection of the south line of said Sec. 1 with the meander line of Puget Sound; thence along said meander line, and along the meander line of Sinclair Inlet, Port Orchard and Liberty Bay to a point where said meander line intersects the east line of Sec. 26, T. 26 N., R. 1 E.; thence north along the east lines of Secs. 26, 23, 14 and 11, T. 26 N., R. 1 E., to the northeast corner of said Sec. 11; thence west along the north lines of Secs. 11, 10, 9, 8 and 7, T. 26 N., R. 1 E., to a point where the north line of said Sec. 7 intersects the easterly meander line of Hood Canal, the point of beginning.
