NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATIONS

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities, Dockets UE-150204 and UG-150205 (consolidated)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 25, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered its Final Order in Avista Corporation's 2014 general rate proceeding.¹ In that order, the Commission directed Commission Staff to open an investigatory docket for the purpose of convening a forum to address attrition,² citing a clear consensus among the settling parties regarding the need for a formalized discussion of attrition along with other possible ratemaking mechanisms that may address the effects of attrition on earnings.³ The Commission further stated that it expects the forum to be inclusive, open to participation by not only the parties in the proceeding under Dockets UE-140188 and UG-140189, but also the broader community of Commission-regulated utility companies and interested consumer groups.⁴

To understand better the causes of utility earnings attrition and possible ratemaking mechanisms to address them, the Commission has scheduled a workshop as a recessed open meeting on **Thursday, April 16, 2015**.⁵
