1 **SYNOPSIS:** *The Commission revokes the registration of Comtex Corporation as a telecommunications company for failure to comply with Commission orders.*

2 **NATURE OF PROCEEDING:** In this Order the Commission reviews an initial order that proposes to revoke the registration of Comtex Corporation as a telecommunications company in the state of Washington for failure to comply with Commission orders.

3 **INITIAL ORDER:** An initial order was entered on April 5, 2002, by Administrative Law Judge Karen M. Caillé proposing that the registration of Comtex as a telecommunications company be revoked because it had failed to file an annual report for 2000, failed to submit calculations and pay its regulatory fees for 2000, failed to comply with the terms of the Commission’s order approving Comtex’s registration as a telecommunications company, failed to respond to a Commission order requesting information on the company’s compliance with WAC 480-120-040, and failed to respond to a Commission order assessing penalties.

4 **PETITION FOR REVIEW:** No petition for administrative review was filed within the 20 days allowed by rule for filing. The copy of the initial order that was served upon the respondent in accordance with RCW 34.05.461(9) at its address on file with the Commission was returned to the Commission by the United States Post Office with the notation that the addressee had moved and left no forwarding address. The Commission has reviewed the proposed order and the evidence of record and believes that the findings, the conclusions, and the order are consistent with the record. In accordance with RCW 34.05.464 and WAC 480-09-780(6), the Commission accepts the findings of fact and conclusions of law, and adopts the Initial Order as its own, for purposes of this proceeding.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS That:

- 6 The registration of Comtex Corporation as a telecommunications company in the state of Washington, which was granted by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission in Docket No. UT-981174, is revoked.
