- Proceeding. Docket No. UT-023023 is a complaint brought by Pac-West Telecomm, Inc. (Pac-West) against Qwest Communications, Inc., f/k/a U S WEST Communications, Inc. (Qwest) for enforcement of an interconnection agreement. The complaint alleges that Qwest is refusing to pay Pac-West monies due for transportation of ISP traffic under reciprocal compensation terms in the agreement.
- Background. The Commission scheduled a prehearing conference for May 31, 2002, to consider formulating the issues in this proceeding, to discuss whether the proceeding should be heard as a complaint or as a petition for enforcement proceeding under WAC 480-09-530, and to establish a procedural schedule.
- On May 28, 2002, Pac-West filed a voluntary motion to dismiss the complaint without prejudice. Pac-West represents that the parties are working towards settlement of the complaint. Following Pac-West's motion, the Commission cancelled the prehearing conference scheduled for May 31, 2002.
- Commission Discussion and Decision. The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this proceeding. It is consistent with the public interest to dismiss the complaint filed by Pac-West.

## ORDER

Pac-West's motion to dismiss the complaint without prejudice is granted and this proceeding is terminated.
