The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission has filed with the Code Reviser proposed administrative revisions to rules in Title 480 of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC). This proposal would update WAC references, clean up language and outdated material, and reflect recent changes in legislation in Title 480 WAC. The Commission filed the proposed changes as an expedited rulemaking (CR-105) under Docket No. A-030832.
