## TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 12, 2006, the parties advised the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) that they had entered into a stipulation settling this complaint. The stipulation required the respondent Western Moving & Storage to change its corporate name, amend its articles of incorporation to reflect a new name, and stop advertising its services under its old name. On January 19, 2007, the parties advised the Commission that respondent had complied with the terms of the stipulation and requested that the complaint be dismissed. They further requested that the Commission cancel the hearing scheduled for January 26, 2007.

The Commission reviews settlements to determine whether they promote the public interest. In order to assist the Commission in determining whether the stipulation in this case serves the public interest and whether the complaint should be dismissed, the Commission requests the parties submit a statement describing the public interest impact of their stipulation and request for dismissal. The parties should file their statement on or before February 7, 2007.
