On September 24, 2012, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC (Qwest) and Pass Word, Inc., filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a request for approval of an interconnection agreement amendment (amendment). The amendment is a delegated item scheduled for approval by December 22, 2012.

WAC 480-07-640 requires interconnection agreements or amendments be submitted for approval within 30 days after they are signed. The last signature appearing on the interconnection agreement is dated August 23, 2012, 2 days late. The Commission reserves the right to investigate and, if appropriate, commence a separate proceeding to complain, enforce, and penalize Qwest for failure to meet the filing requirements.
