TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On October 12, 2009, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Draft Request for Proposals from All Generation Sources and Energy Efficiency Programs (RFP).

The RFP is required by WAC 480-107. WAC 480-107-015 (3) (b) specifies that all interested parties shall be provided a 60-day public comment period on PSE's RFP to acquire new generating and demand-side resources through a competitive bidding process. Following the comment period the Commission has 30 days to take action with respect to the solicitation for new resources.

Written comments should be filed with the Commission, bearing the above docket number, no later than **December 11, 2009**. Comments should be addressed to Mr. David W. Danner, Executive Director and Secretary, Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, PO Box 47250, Olympia, WA 98504-7250.

The draft RFP is currently scheduled for Commission decision at a recessed open meeting of the Commission to be held on **Wednesday, December 23, 2009**, immediately following the Commission's open meeting, which is scheduled to start at 9:30 a.m. The meeting will be held at the Commission's headquarters, Room 206, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.
