I am writing to serve protest to the WUTC regarding temporary authority granted Jason M Nelson d.b.a. Parkers Moving Services. A review of the application submitted by Mr Nelson shows that as the owner of Parker Moving Services he has not opened the required account with the state Department of Labor and Industries for worker's compensation, nor has he registered with the Employment Security Department although he has an active Craigslist advertisement dated 5/3/2011. Similarly he has advertised his services for rates which are less than the minimum rates established by the WUTC's Tariff 15C for household goods relocation. Clearly there is a gap between business practices engaged in by Mr Nelson and those required of other licensed household goods movers. Similarly the question of fitness becomes an issue when an applicant does not establish mandatory accounts or complete required registrations of his business prior to commencing operations.

I am surprised that absent compliance with these basic requirements for businesses operating in the household goods moving business in Washington, temporary authority would be granted.
