I. JUDGMENT SUMMARY

- 1.1 Judgment Creditor: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission

1 defendant Daryl Munn d/b/a Innovative Moving Co. in Commission Docket
2 TV-131608, by immediately ceasing and desisting from engaging in business as
3 a household goods carrier in Washington State without first obtaining from the
4 Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission the permit required under
5 RCW 81.80.075.
6

7 2. Defendant Daryl Munn d/b/a Innovative Moving Co. and all successors,
8 assigns, and transferees are hereby enjoined and permanently restrained from
9 directly or indirectly engaging in any of the following conduct:

10 a. Engaging in business as a household goods carrier by transporting
11 household goods for compensation, by motor vehicle between points in
12 Washington state, without first obtaining a household goods common
13 carrier permit from the Washington Utilities and Transportation
14 Commission.

16 b. Engaging in business as a household goods carrier by advertising,
17 soliciting, offering, or entering into an agreement to transport household
18 goods, without first obtaining a household goods common carrier permit
19 from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.

21 3. Defendant Daryl Munn d/b/a Innovative Moving Co. is directed to pay a civil
22 penalty of \$20,000 for engaging in business as a household goods carrier
23 without first obtaining from the Washington Utilities and Transportation
24 Commission a household goods common carrier permit required under RCW
25 81.80.075 in violation of a cease and desist order issued by the Washington
26

1 Utilities and Transportation Commission under RCW 81.04.510.

2 4. Plaintiffs are awarded costs and fees and other disbursements associated with
3 the filing and maintenance of the petition for enforcement, including reasonable
4 attorneys' fees, in the amount of \$570.

5
6 5. The Court retains jurisdiction to enforce this Order.


