

**SCHEDULE 20**

**RELOCATION FORWARDING SERVICE**

A. General

Relocation Forwarding Service (RFS) is a voice only application service which allows calls sent to a telephone number programmed in the central office to automatically forward to a customer's terminating premises equipment or voice mail box. The customer's premises equipment or voice mail box may be located in the same or different exchange from the call forwarding location.

4. Transmission characteristics may vary depending on the distance and routing necessary to complete the forwarded call.
5. Call Forwarding is not available as a feature at the RFS terminating Station.
