NOTICE RESCINDING INTENT TO
SUSPEND CERTIFICATE AND
OPERATING AUTHORITY

- 1 On March 30, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Granting Mitigation to \$1,000, reducing the penalty assessed against Good & Goods, LLC d/b/a The Original Cannabis (Good & Goods or Company) for 17 violations of WAC 480-30-221. That order required the Company to pay the mitigated penalty no later than April 13, 2016.
- 2 As of June 29, 2016, the Commission's records indicated that Good & Goods had not paid the penalty. On that date, the Commission issued a notice that it intended to suspend the Company's certificate and authority to provide charter and excursion service pursuant to WAC 480-30-171(1) until Good & Goods paid the penalty.
- 3 The Commission's records indicate that Good & Goods paid the penalty on July 8, 2016. The Commission, therefore, no longer intends to suspend the Company's certificate and operating authority.
- 4 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it rescinds its intent to suspend the certificate and operating authority of Good & Goods to provide passenger transportation services.**
