Subject: TR-161023 – City of Millwood Completion of Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) Project Marguerite Street – 662513B

On September 19, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) awarded a GCPF grant totaling \$254,222 to the City of Millwood (City) for a project involving installation of active warning devices at the Marguerite Street crossing in Millwood, identified as USDOT 662513B. This crossing was identified in the 2014 Marine and Rail Oil Transportation Study as an under-protected crossing on an oil route. The actual cost for the installation was \$250,907.85.

On October 23, 2017, the City submitted a request for reimbursement. Rail Safety staff inspected the crossing on October 25, 2017, and confirmed that the installation of the active warning devices was completed according to the specifications outlined in the order approving the grant.
