DECLARATION OF WAYNE
GILBERT

- 1 I, Wayne Gilbert, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington, declare as follows:
- 2 I am over 18 years of age, a citizen of the United States, a resident of the State of Washington, and competent to be a witness.
- 3 I am employed by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (“Commission”) as a Motor Carrier Safety Investigator, Transportation Safety. My duties include conducting investigations into companies that may be operating in violation of Commission rules or State statutes enforced by the Commission. As part of those duties, I investigate whether companies are in compliance with the rules of the Commission, including the rules found in WAC 480-15.
- 4 On February 21, 2019, I conducted an inspection to assess We Like to Move It, Move It!! LLC’s (“Company”) compliance with Commission rules and orders, including the Commission’s household goods training requirement pursuant to WAC 480-15-305. I spoke with the Company’s owner, Joshua Manion, and conveyed that the Company was not in compliance with WAC 480-15-305, and that the Company needed to complete the required training as soon as possible. I provided Mr. Manion with information on how to enroll in the April 2019 Commission-sponsored training, and provided him with contact information for a Commission representative who could assist his registration in that training.
- 5 To the best of my knowledge, and as of the date of this declaration, no Company representative has attended the Commission-sponsored household goods training as required under WAC 480-15-305.
