## TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 21, 2018, the Commission issued an order instituting a special proceeding on its own motion to determine whether Zhongxiang Ye, Tiger Express Shipping Corporation d/b/a Tiger Travel (Tiger Travel), has engaged, and is engaging, in unlawful operations following the cancellation of its charter and excursion carrier certificate in violation of RCW 81.70.260.

The Commission ordered that Tiger Travel appear before the Commission in this classification proceeding on April 11, 2018, at the Commission's headquarters in Olympia, Washington, to give testimony and evidence under oath as to its operations.

On April 11, 2018, a representative for Tiger Travel appeared before the Commission and requested a continuance of the proceeding. Tiger Travel informed the Commission that it had recently retained counsel, and that Tiger Travel requested the continuance to allow time for its counsel to prepare for the proceeding. Tiger Travel and Commission staff agreed to continue the classification proceeding on June 4, 2018.

Based on Tiger Travel's counsel's limited time to prepare and the parties' agreement, the Commission finds good cause to continue the classification proceeding to June 4, 2018, at 1:30 p.m.
